2019 Midwest Prime Time Jr. Hereford Regional Rules

1. Show is open to any exhibitor that has not reached their 22nd birthday as of January 1, 2019.
2. **Entries are due JUNE 1, 2019.** All entries mailed must be postmarked no later than June 1.
3. **Bark is included** with the cost of the entry.
4. There will be two rings with two judges.
5. Midwest Prime Time, Hancock County Fairgrounds and all volunteers are not responsible for any theft, loss or damage of property or livestock.
6. Entry fee is \$60 per head per class. Late entry fees (anything after June 1 will be \$100 per head). Entry fee is for two rings. **There are no refunds under any circumstances.**
7. All animals must be registered with the AHA.
8. Horned and Polled heifers will show together.
9. Calves at side of cow/calf pairs may show separate heifer or bull shows.
10. Cattle age requirements:
Heifers – born after August 1, 2017
Bulls- born after August 1, 2017
Steers- January 1, 2018 and younger
Cow/Calf – Cows born prior to August 1, 2017. Calf must be born after October 14, 2018. The exhibitor must be the breeder of the calf.
11. Steers are not required to have DNA profile on file at the AHA.
12. Bred & Owned Bulls and Heifers must be bred and owned by the exhibitor showing.
13. Bulls born before January 1, 2019 must be shown with a nose lead.
14. Tie outs are available. No cattle are allowed to be tied to trailers. You must bring your own bedding. You must clean up tie out before leaving.
15. Midwest Prime Time will be offering Owned Heifer, Bred & Owned Heifer, Cow/Calf, Bred & Owned Bull and Steer classes.
16. All classes will be broke by age, except steers, which will be broke by weight.
17. Generators and wheel barrows are encouraged.
18. Entries must meet Ohio health requirements. All animals must have an official health certificate. Please refer to Ohio health requirements at interstatelivestock.com for additional information.
19. All decisions of the show committee are final.
20. Only exhibitors under the age requirement are allowed to show animals in the show ring.
21. Any animal getting loose three times, will be excused.
22. Cattle are released after the conclusion of the shows.
23. The Midwest Prime Time Jr. Hereford Regional is a family event. Any false representation, interference or unsportsmanlike conduct on the part of any attendee will be dealt with by Midwest Prime Time committee. If any attendee interferes in any way with the judges or shows disrespect to them, or to the show, the Midwest Prime Time committee may withhold any awards or take any other steps deemed desirable.
24. Hancock County Cattlemen will have food available Friday - Sunday. Breakfast and lunch will be available.
25. Camping is available at a rate of \$25 per night.
